Below is the 92NY Afterschool Code of Conduct

(This is to ensure that we are all on the same page for behavior expectations)

Step 1- The first time a child is physically aggressive (hits, kicks, pinches, bites, etc), they are to meet with the room supervisor

Step 2- The second time a child is physically aggressive, a meeting occurs with the Director or Program Associate

Step 3- The Director will speak with counselors and conduct observations to determine appropriate intervention

Step 4- If the child hits again after a behavioral plan is put into place, the Director is called to consult with the child and the child does not receive positive reinforcement for their behavior

Step 5- The next time they will need to miss out on time with their peers

Step 6- Should they hit again, they will receive a one-day suspension from Afterschool and a meeting will need to occur with parents to discuss the child's future at Afterschool.

Step 7- After an Afterschool suspension, if the child hits again, it will result in a permanent removal from Afterschool

The 92nd Street Y reserves the right and has the sole discretion to terminate and/or limit the participation of a child if it is deemed that a child's behavior is inappropriate for or harmful to the well-being of the program.
