Recanati-Kaplan scholar in music Anaïs Reno is a singer specializing in jazz and blues. After winning the 2016 Forte International Competition's Platinum Award at Carnegie Hall, Anaïs won second prize at Michael Feinstein's Great American Songbook Academy Competition in Carmel, in 2018, and first prize at the Mabel Mercer Foundation Competition in 2019. She has had three solo shows at Feinstein's 54 Below with Billy Stritch and Tedd Firth. She has performed at the Friar's Club, the National Arts Club and the Player's Club. She has also performed several times at Carnegie Hall.



Eason Rytter is a vocalist and actor, and a Recanati-Kaplan scholar in music. Eason recently appeared with Russell Crowe and Sienna Miller in the Golden Globe-nominated Showtime miniseries *The Loudest Voice*. Eason has appeared Off-Broadway alongside Martha Plimpton, Jim Brochu, Scarlett Strallen, and Bryce Pinkham with Gingold Theatrical Group. Eason has worked extensively for Nickelodeon, voicing animated characters for television shows like *Bubble Guppies* and *Paw Patrol*.



Recanati-Kaplan art scholar Audrey Zhang has been drawing almost every day since she was two years old. She prefers using black ink pen to draw images from her mind, and almost every picture of hers is different. The winner of many art competitions, she was named national champion for Google 4 Doodle in 2014. Audrey graduated from the R-K Scholars program in 2021 and is currently a student at Yale University.
