This position requires strong design and CSS skills as well as familiarity with HTML5 and information architecture.

Essential Functions

- Design user interfaces, typography, web icons, rollover graphics, cross-sell graphics, photo collages, animated and static ad, online tours and web pages required to maintain and enhance the 92nd Street Y web presence.
- Create online advertising for websites (flash, animated gifs, jpgs)
- Create HTML emails for content distribution
- Research, scan, photograph create, optimize photography and graphics for the internet
- Maintain database and filing system for projects and images used online
- Work with the other 92Y staff to keep all web graphics and content up-to-date
- Performs other related duties as assigned or requested

Educational Requirements

Bachelor's degree in graphic / web design and /or comparable and extensive technical website development experience

Skills and Experience Required

- Two to three years minimum experience in a fast paced graphic and web production environment.
- Strong understanding of web standards and best practices for user interface design, as well as a creative eye.
- Excellent graphic ability and a portfolio demonstrating these skills.
- Meticulous attention to detail, excellent organizational and communication skills.

- Must have extensive knowledge of PhotoShop, Fireworks, Dreamweaver, Illustrator and InDesign.

- Experience with Kentico CMS, WordPress or other CMS experience a plus.
