Ink Wash

If you prefer, you can wait to get the inking supplies after the first day demo, just come in on the first day with paper and pencil.

Pencils, a standard HB pencil, some soft pencils, such as a 4B, a 5B or a 6B.

PAPER – minimum of 140 lb. (300gsm) watercolor paper, 11 x 15 inches or larger.
(Any texture, loose leaf or brick)

PALLET or multiple plastic cups - 6-9 wells for mixing tones, (Cheap plastic pallets work & are an inch deep)

Black drawing Ink, (Yasutomo drawing ink in the green bottle)

BRUSHES – (daler rowney makes a 5 brush watercolor value set)

Purchase a range of sizes, synthetic bristles are fine, sable and squirrel are best.

- 1 **wash** brush (mop) – 2-3”

- 2 **medium** brushes - round or flat

- 2 **small** brushes – liner/ round/ or rigger brush.

- **Multiple large chip brushes or painters brushes**. Any larger flat brush 2, or 3 inches in width.

WATER CONTAINER- plastic yogurt containers or coffee containers are fine

Blue painters tape or Ph neutral Masking tape

Drawing board

Rubber kneaded eraser

Magic rub eraser
