## **Supply List**

**Oil Paints:** Pick up small tubes for most of the colors and a large one for titanimum white. Purchase only artist-grade paints, not student-grade. Please avoid colors called "tint" or "hue".

alizarin crimson viridian green permanent green med.
cadmium red medium cerulean blue cadmium lemon yellow

cadmium yellow medium ultramarine blue titanium white

**Brushes:** Look for brushes suitable for oil painting. Bristle or synthetic can work. - but someone at the art supply store could easily direct you. Select a range of sizes, small and large (from #2 to #10) for: Flats, Rounds and Filberts

## Canvas:

- Two or three canvas boards or pre-stretched canvases (16" x2 0" and/or 18" x 24")
- One canvas pad (16" x 20")
- One drawing board larger than 16"x 20" (support for canvas pad sheets)

## Miscellaneous:

- Two metal palette knives
- Small jar cold-pressed linseed oil
- Drawing pencil and eraser
- Roll masking tape
- Latex gloves (box)
- Paper towels (Bounty)
- Cotton rags
- Two small glass or metal jars with lids to hold liquid
- Bar of Ivory soap or soap for cleaning brushes
- One disposable paper paltte (11"x 16")
