SUPPLY LIST

**Greek Leather: round cord - 1.5 mm diameter. Approx.. 5 meters.
(black or dk brown will be available)

**Assortment of beads: 4mm to 6mm round or faceted - may be glass or other material - good size holes and no sharp edges are advised.
8/0 and/or 6/0 seed beads - round, cubes, etc. - small amounts

**Metal button with a shank - approx.. size of a dime. or 2 hole
button w/ large holes for leather to pass through.

**Thread - Nymo D or equivalent to match color of leather.

**Needles: #10 and/or #12 Stiff English Beading Needles (not Sharps)
4 needles.

Misc.: Bee's wax, Beading awl (if you have one - do not buy.),
T-pins, Cloth measuring tape, Small Scissors, Cloth to put beads on.
Masking tape

Student Guidelines & Studio Rules

Studios are open 15 min before the start of class.

Do not enter any studio without your instructor present.

Do not enter a studio until the previous class has ended and all the participants have left the room and your instructor is present.

Students must leave studios after their class is over.

Do not use any tool that you are unfamiliar with as it could permanently damage the tool particularly hammers.

Only use hammers that you are familiar with like a “hardware hammer” if it doesn’t look familiar don’t use it you will ruin it.

Exhaust fans must be turned on when torches are being used or any materials is being melted.

Tools & Torches are coded with six different colors which denote the studios they belong in and their use;

Blue S353

Yellow S355

Red S352

Orange S350
