- Copper or silver sheet, 20 or 22 gauge
- Dividers
- Jeweler's saw frame (optional)
- 2/0 blades, dozen
- Flat nose pliers
- Hand and needle files
- Wet/dry sandpaper or sanding sticks, 220-600 grit
