DRAWING MEDIA

- Pencils -a variety of hardnesses
- Colored pencils
- Watercolor pencils
- Graphite chunks i(color ones such as derwent XL are fun)
- Charcoal
- Pastels
- Erasers- kneaded and hard plastic
- Portable sharpener

PAINTING MEDIA

- Watercolor
- Gouache
- Markers or brush pens
- Watercolor pencils
- Brushes
- Container for water

ADDITIONAL ITEMS

- Sketch pads with appropriate paper for your media.
- Travel wipes are handy! There are restrooms but only at the entrance to the gardens.
- A lightweight portable stool is not required but could be helpful. There are some benches but not always where you want them!
