Intro to the Adobe Photoshop, Lightroom and Bridge

Welcome New Students,

In this two-session class we will introduce students to the organizing and editing power of Adobe's Photographers Plan, which includes Lightroom, Photoshop and Bridge. We will discuss the differences between the programs, basic organizing and editing in each program, and when to use one or the other or both. We will also discuss how to start creating an effective digital archive and editing workflow.

We have Macs that you can work on during class or you are welcome to bring your own laptops.

If you are using your own laptop, please make sure that you have the Photographers Plan installed on it when you come to the first class. It is a subscription that costs \$9.99 per month, but it downloads to your computer and you can get it online from Adobe or through stores like B&H, which sell the annual subscription. Adobe includes three programs with the Photographers Plan that you can download when you subscribe. The basic ones are Photoshop CC, Lightroom Classic CC, Lightroom CC. You should also be able to download a program called Bridge, which is another very useful organizer. For the class I would like you to make sure that you have Photoshop CC, Lightroom Classic CC, and Bridge

If you are going to be using the Y's computers, please bring in photos to practice on, either on a USB thumb drive or on a portable hard drive.

Everyone should try and bring in a camera memory card with photos on it for practice downloading using the Photographers Plan programs.
