Besides the usual array of hand tools the student should already have (round nose pliers, chain nose pliers, burnisher, files, needle files, saws, drill bits, sandpaper, soldering supplies, etc.), they should also bring some form of magnification, such as an optivisor. A millimeter gauge and a divider is also required for setting stones.

Silver solder should be brought – hard and medium

For the ring(s): A one foot long, two mm thick, 5 mm wide half round silver wire

Other metals to be brought for the settings:
1 ft. 20 ga. Sterling silver round wire
1X 3" 18 ga silver sheet.
1X 3" 24 ga silver sheet.
1X 3" 22 ga silver sheet.

Exhaust fans must be turned on when torches are being used or any materials is being melted.

Tools & Torches are coded with six different colors which denote the studios they belong in and their use; Blue S353 Yellow S355 Red S352 Orange S350 LIGHT BLUE INSTRUCTOR'S BOX NOT FOR STUDENT USE. Green children's classes

If you borrow a tool from another room return it at the end of class time.

Library books are for reference only please return them in their proper order.

Students are responsible for cleaning the space they have used including the soldering station and bricks and returning tools at the end of class.
