Supplies for Painting enamels

For first class: Notebook, Pencil, pen.

<u>Please note:</u> It is not necessary to purchase all supplies on the list. As this is an online introductory class this list may serve as a reference for future exploration.

- Brushes: Good watercolor brushes: small round for applying enamel (or other fine tip good *sable* round brushes)-round, size 2; round, size 1; round, size 0; round, size 2/0; round size 3/0 recommended Small Flat (a half inch wide) watercolor brush

- Small spatula (e.g. https://www.dickblick.com/products/lineco-micro-spatula/)
- Glass brush (optional)
- Alundum stone or diamond sanding sticks
- Dust mask for sifting enamel
- Eye dropper
- small china plate, porcelain palette or small tile
- Plastic (or glass) jars with lids (2 oz-4 oz)
- Green IR safety glasses (recommended)
- Sifters: 80, 100, 150, 200, 325 mesh (optional)
- Scriber (or toothpicks, needle, Exacto) for sgraffito
- 80 mesh Enamels: 1030 Foundation White (or 1040 Quill White)-8 oz, 2030 Clear transparent-medium- 4 oz
- Copper pieces, 18 or 20 guage, pre-enameled with base coat and counter (Foundation White or light opaque)
- Lavender oil
- Masking tape
