Watercolor Painting (Basic/Intermediate)

Supply List for Melanie Kozol:

- Watercolor Brushes - Winsor-Newton & Lowe-Cornell, Isabey, short handle. A selection of round, flat and 1 mop brush (#16, #12, #10, #8, #4) Flat wash brush (½" or 1")
- Sketch pad
- Watercolor Paper: Arches cold pressed, 140 lb. 11 x 14 (tablet or block)
- Palettes should have at least 10 wells/depressions and should have ample flat surface area for mixing colors. Mijello Fusion Airtight

Watercolor tubes- artist grade or small set. Recommended brands: Holbein, Sennelier, Schmincke, Windsor Newton	
Essential colors:	Optional:
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Hansa yellow, Lemon or AZO Yellow• Cadmium red• Alizarin crimson (permanent)• Ultramarine blue• Pthalo Blue• Viridian or Pthalo Green	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Cadmium Yellow Medium• Burnt Sienna• Payne's grey, Ivory black• Burnt sienna• Yellow ochre• Raw Sienna• Cobalt Violet• Cadmium orange

Miscellaneous:

- Water containers (two, old yogurt containers fine)
- Paper towels, sponge
- Masking tape or bullnose clips
- Butter knife or palette knife

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Supply List for Bonnie Steinsynder:

- Brushes: #6 and #10 rounds, 1 inch wash brush. Scepter Gold, Escoda Versatil, Princeton Aqua Elite and most of the mid-price good synthetics are ok. A cheap, stiff #5 synthetic brush for lifting.

Watercolor tubes- artist grade or small set. Recommended brands: Daniel Smith, Schminke, Holbein, Sennelier, Grumbacher, Rembrandt and Winsor Newton (*denotes colors from Winsor Newton) Cotman, Van Gogh and Grumbacher Academy (student grade) are ok. <i>Do not use children's paint sets or Reeves; there is too much filler and not good pigment.</i>	
Essential colors:	
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Winsor lemon yellow (cool)*• Cadmium yellow medium (warm)• Alizarin crimson permanent (cool)• Winsor red (warm)*• Pthalo Blue (cool) or Winsor blue – red shade (cool)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Ultramarine blue (warm)• Winsor green - blue shade (cool)* or Pthalo green (cool)• Hookers green (warm) or Sap green (warm)• Burnt sienna• Yellow ochre• Burnt umber
Optional: Quinacridone magenta is a beautiful cool purple-pink, great for roses. Paynes Gray is useful. <i>You don't need black or white paint.</i>	

- A white plastic palette for laying out your tube colors and for mixing. Folding palettes close to about 5"x10" if space is a problem. Covered palettes are easier to work with but take up more space.
- Paper:
 - a sketch pad for planning in pencil
 - a 9"x12" pad of cold press, 140 lb. watercolor paper for experimenting with technique and testing color; Kilimanjaro, Montval are ok.
 - a 9"x12" or 11"x14" block of Arches cold press, 140 lb. paper. This is a better paper and will give you better results.

Miscellaneous: plastic pint container for water, paper towels (Bounty), 2B and HB pencils, kneaded eraser, small real sponge, and masking tape.

Optional: Masking fluid (do not shake it), a cheap brush to apply it with, and a white china marker (wax pencil) are optional.

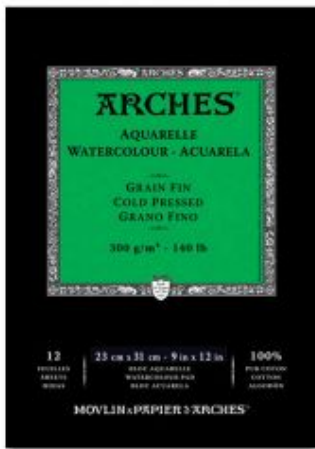
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Supply List Allison Maletz:

- Hard Pencil (HB or 2H)
- Kneaded Eraser
- 9x12"-11x14" This is the best: **Arches Watercolor PAD, 140 lb. Cold Pressed, 9" x 12"** (the "block" is triple the price, don't buy that) (12 sheets). (\$15) A good alternative is **Legion Stonehenge Aqua Watercolor Block, 140 Cold Press, 9 X 12 inches, 15 Sheets, White**

- Tray/Palette - A metal travel palette with a lid and at least 12 wells for different colors. <https://www.dickblick.com/products/mijello-fusion-airtightleakproof-palettes/>

- A range of Watercolor Brush Sizes varying from round and flat: 0 round, 4 or 6 flat, 10 round, 20 Flat, for example (you will know them from oil brushes because the bristles on water-based brushes are very soft to the touch.) I recommend: Princeton Art and Brush Co. Princeton Series 9000 Brown Handled Brush, Set of 7: <https://www.amazon.com/Princeton-Art-Brush-P9143->

- 1 water container, a plastic cup or coffee tin (anything out of the recycle bin will do.)
- Watercolor paint tubes. I would recommend buying a box of 8-15 small tubes of all the basic colors. ***At the very minimum you must have primary colors: Cadmium Red Deep, Cadmium Yellow, Ultramarine Blue, Lamp Black, and Burnt Umber. (No White, Naples Yellow, or "Flesh Tint") I recommend opening the tubes of paint in the store to make sure the colors look "primary" aka, that the red is really RED and not an orangey red, etc.
- **Colors I use** (and you can add them to your palette in this order - This is not mandatory, mainly for those who are curious): Burnt Umber, Raw Sienna, Crimson, Deep Red, Alizarin, Opera, Vermilion, Deep Yellow, Light Yellow, Lemon Yellow, Yellow Ocher, Olive Green, Sap Green, Shadow Green, Viridian, Ultramarine Blue, Cobalt, Prussian Blue, Violet, Payne's Gray, Black.
