**PROCEDURE FOR UNDERGRADUATE
NON-MATRICULATED ENROLLMENT**

- 1) Fill out a [Application for Nondegree Undergraduate Studies](#) to become an ESC student. It is VERY important choose the Manhattan location (325 Hudson Street) when asked, and to stress that you will be studying at DEL. Do this as early as possible as processing takes several weeks.
- 2) Send an email to **Lucy Winner** Lucy.Winner@esc.edu and cc: NYCretention@esc.edu to say that you have submitted your application and are DEL or Dance Therapy student and wish to be assigned to Lucy Winner.
- 3) Email Lucy Winner the studies that you wish to enroll in and she will make you a registration worksheet.
- 4) Complete your registration for these studies before the registration deadline.
