ATTENTION – FOR ALL OIL PAINTING STUDENTS: In order to maintain healthy, safe, and environmentally conscious studios the following materials ARE NOT PERMITTED in the 92Y Art Center: Lavender Oil; Odorless Mineral Spirits; Turpentine; Liquin, Neo-Meglip, Galkyd, or any other petroleum based medium; varnish or retouch varnish; any other solvent beside Gamsol.

Supply List:

*supplies with asterisks required for first class.

*Vine Charcoal Small Sketchpad Small, hand held mirror

*Canvas

*Brushes: *Please come to the first class with at least 2 or 3 brushes. Pick from the recommended:

- Bristle Filberts #1, #3, #6*, #8 and #10*
- House painting brush (Bristle, not acrylic) ½"

- Sable Round #6 or #4
- Fan Brush
- Synthetic or Sable Flat #1 and #4

Palette Knife (trowel-type, long and thin)

*Palette Cups: Two: *one for solvent and the other for medium

Medium: Choose from Stand Oil, Linseed Oil or Liquin *Palette: Grey palette (disposable, or make your own)

*Paints: "W&N Winton" Oils or other student grade grand for beginners. Winsor & Newton or other professional grade for advanced students.

Colors: (in order of placement on palette)

- *Titanium White (W&N Griffin Alkyd version or other brand of oil Titanium White. Don't get the regular W&N Titanium white.)
- Naples Yellow
- Cadmium Yellow
- *Yellow Ochre
- Raw Sienna

- Cadmium Red
- Alizarin Crimson
- *Burnt Sienna
- Raw Umber
- *Ultramarine Blue
- Viridian Green
- *Ivory Black

Try to get most of the colors. But if this is not feasible, try to get a minimal collection of the colors with asterisks next to them.

Color Pencils (for monochromatic drawing): *I prefer Stabilo Original series 87655 (Sanguine), but it is unavailable in the United States. A good substitute is: Supra-Color Hard and Soft Russet #065. Other dark colors work also.*

Pitt (Faber-Castell), Sanguine #112920 (oil based), #1122-188 (pastel) Cretacolor 462 02 (Sanguine oil based pencil) and/or 262 02 (with holder) Vine Charcoal, Hard, Medium, Soft

Graphite Pencils #s 2H, H, HB, B

PAPERS

Choice of:

19X24 Bond (Borden #39), Canson "Biggie Sketch" (50 lb), and others 18X24 Newsprint (smooth or rough)

DRAWING BOARD

18X24 Masonite board or Canvas board Clips (to hold the paper)

ALSO

Small hand-held mirror

Eraser (Mars Staedtler white plastic and Tuff Stuff eraser)
